



Trick or Treat Safety

Costumes:



Wear light colored or reflective type clothing to be more visible. Put reflective tape on your Trick or Treat Bags too.



Wear a flame retardant costume. Avoid long trailing or billowing features that could cause you to trip.



Paint your face instead of wearing a mask. Wearing a loose fitting mask can block your vision.

On the Streets:



Have an adult go with you. Plan your route and share it with your family.



Carry a flashlight for lighting or as part of a custom.



Stay in well lit areas and only visit homes with porch lights on.



Walk on the sidewalk and not on the street when possible.



Always look both ways before crossing the street.



Don't walk between parked cars. Always cross on street corners.



Be cautious of strangers and animals.

Treats:



Have an adult inspect your candy. Don't eat candy if the package is open. Small pieces of hard candy are a choking hazard for your children.
